MITZI'S OATES unhurried in the early going, racing five wide around the first turn, moved up around the final turn, drove clear and won under urging. SALTY TAM raced near the back in the early part, came around the second turn on the outside, moved up and made a bid down the lane, was no match for the winner, but was clearly second. B. B. GUN raced within contention, saved ground and lacked a late rally. GO ZIPPY GO raced near the rear in the early part, came around the first turn five wide, made a mild bid late, but was no factor. DIPPITY DEAL void of early speed, improved position, but was no threat. WATCH THE STORM broke slow and was never close. FAITH HOPE LOVE sprinted to the front, opened up on the field, then faltered down the home stretch, pulled up lame after crossing the wire and was vanned off. HOLLY SUE raced within striking distance and was finished early. MINE AND YOURS was an early factor, then retreated to the rear.
