DIXIE DOT COM pressed the pace from the start, moved up to take command around the final turn, pulled away and proved much the best, setting a new track record. FAN THE FLAME went to the front and led until leaving the final turn, proved no match for the winner, but was clearly second. BIG NUMBERS unhurried, racing evenly near the middle of the field and made a late bid, but was no match for the top two. CUSTER raced within contention, came around the second turn on the outside, finished wide down the stretch and put forth an even effort. FIVE STRAIGHT pressed the early pace, saved ground in the early going and lacked a late rally. DESERT DEMON raced near the rear in the beginning, saved ground around the final turn and was never close. REBRIDLED always raced near the back and showed little. REMINGTON ROCK void of early speed, trailed the field, never fired.
