STAKES Ouija Board Distaff H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$12,000 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weights: Sunday, May 20, 2007. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 17, 2007 with 46 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.)

### Footnotes

LADY OF VENICE (FR) was taken back early then reserved while a bit rank, waited while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied six wide into the stretch, closed with a rush to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best while geared down late. BROWNIE POINTS steadied late on the first turn, was reserved on the inside, moved off the rail and was roused on the far turn, hesitated a bit entering the stretch, found clear room outside the furlong marker and finished willingly for the place. RICH FANTASY raced three to four wide on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch, shook clear entering the final furlong but was overtaken then was caught for the place. D FINE OKIE was caught four wide on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, vied outside of RICH FANTASY on the far turn, lost touch with that rival entering the final furlong and weakened. BARBETTE raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MY THREE SISTERS was reserved while between rivals, came three wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SWEET IDEA was well placed on the inside, came under a ride while continuing to save ground on the far turn and dropped out. PROSPECTORS SPIRIT raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 0 Feet)
