**Footnotes**

SMOKEN SMOKE tracked the leader, gained the lead at the top of the stretch and edged clear under strong urging. CONVALLARIA settled on the inside, lugged out a bit on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and secured the place while unable to threaten the winner. BG HI HI IS BEN settled on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened while able to get the show. JADE HARBOR was reluctant to load, set the pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. CAPTAIN KIRK broke outward at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced in tight quarters from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. WINNER'S STORY raced towards the rear of the field, went three wide on the turn and failed to respond. EL MOJO lacked early speed, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and was outrun.
