Footnotes

KLONDIKE EXPRESS settled on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, steadied off heels entering the stretch, moved to the outside, rallied into the final furlong and closed with a rush to get up late. KITTY KATS TALE raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, made a bid between rivals on the far turn, inched clear inside the furlong marker, drifted out a bit late and was denied at the wire. DOT'S TWO SOCKS was fractious in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved up leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SOUTHERN CAUSEWAY raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, made a three wide bid on the far turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened. ADIOS AMIGO followed the clear leader, chased that rival on the far turn and also lacked the needed kick. FULL OF MISCHIEF settled well back in the field and failed to rally. REAGAN JAMES settled well off the pace, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. PASS D SPORTSPAGE broke out a bit at the start, set the clear pace, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and gave way. LOU'S LITTLELIVELY dropped back on the backstretch, went three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and faded. FLIGHTLINE NINER was taken back at the start then angled in at the back of the field, lagged well behind and showed little. (Rail at 0 Feet)
