Footnotes

ANEW RUMOR went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, closed strongly on the outside, drifted in while gaining on the leader and got up late. TIZ READY went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, inched clear inside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. WENCESLAO (MEX) settled on the outside of GORDO AT WAR, was roused on the far turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and finished willingly for the show. SLEW BAYOU TOO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick. SUPREME FOLLY raced four wide early

on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead while off the rail on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. CHIEF REDSTONE raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ARETHEREANYCOOKIES was taken up entering the first turn, lingered towards the rear, went three to four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. HANDSOME GHOST tracked the pace while off the rail, chased on the far turn and came up empty. PRINCE A. J. showed early speed then tracked the pace, raced inside on the turns and also came up empty. GORDO AT WAR settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to respond. L L BIRDWELL settled towards the back, raced near the inside on the turns and was no factor. ROYALTY IN EXCESS lagged at the rear of the field, went two to three wide on the far turn and also was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
