NATES MINESHAFT came away in good order, went straight to the front, was well rated on a very easy lead, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, drew off while being shown the whip and proved much the best while eased up in the final sixteenth. GET IN DA HOUSE raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved at the back, came under urging late on the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and got up for the place. NIGHT PARTY was rank while along the rail then wrestled back midway through the first turn, moved out near the three-quarter pole, was rated just behind the leader while on the outside, chased on the far turn and proved no match then was caught for the place. MARILYN'S GUY lunged at the start, broke about two lengths behind the field, moved up while in hand, went three then four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response then missed the minor awards. GOLDEN YANK went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. APART was rank along the rail early, chomped at the bit, lingered near the back, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and was no factor. FOG ALERT was reserved off the pace, came under urging near the half-mile pole, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and failed to respond. IMCO SPIRIT (IRE) broke out a bit, was in hand while four then three wide on the first turn, raced on the outside while rated, came under urging with a half-mile to run, dropped to the inside on the far turn and faded.
