FLATLAND FEVER dueled on the inside, inched clear in upper stretch and held under strong urging. UNO DUCKSY dropped back while urged along, came three wide into the stretch and closed well but missed. HER MAN chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, battled determinedly on the outside but also missed while clear for the show. SESMARTYGO was well placed just off the pace, chased between rivals on the turn and lacked the needed kick. GARBU ROAD dueled on the outside, vied into upper stretch then weakened. SNOW CAP chased the pace, saved ground on the turn and tired. WILDCAT was ridden along on the outside, raced four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. GLASS MACHINE was hard ridden while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. RED SPIDER was ridden along towards the rear, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. (Rail at 0 Feet)
