STAKES Stonerside S. Listed - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$13,500 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start with \$150,000 guaranteed of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$16,500 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice in 2005 allowed 3 lbs.; \$90,000 in 2005, 5 lbs.; \$30,000 in 2004-2005, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, May 18, 2005 with 37 nominations.

### Footnotes

R FAST LADY hesitated slightly at the start then came out a bit, shifted inside nearing the six-furlong marker, moved closer near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, was roused while making a bid passing the quarter-pole, took the lead at the top of the stretch, edged clear into the final furlong then was fully extended to last under strong handling. FOREVER BRILLIANT broke out slightly, settled on the outside, moved closer near the half-mile marker, was urged along while three wide on the turn, drifted in slightly outside the sixteenth-pole and brushed with TRUE TAILS then gained gradually to just miss. TRUE TAILS set the clear pace while off the rail, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and weakened then brushed with FOREVER BRILLIANT near the sixteenth-pole. AIRIZON tracked the pace on the outside, was urged along between rivals on the turn, dropped out at the top of the stretch and faded.
