FR. DENIS was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the outside, inched clear in upper stretch and held under strong urging. VALID COMMITMENT was well placed behind the leaders, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly to get the place. MR. ROAD WARRIOR brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, moved closer while saving ground on the far turn, shifted out entering the stretch and finished willingly to get the show. COOK'S NOOK brushed with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished. BILLIE BLUE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. MR B SILVER SECRET raced four wide on the first turn, lagged well behind the field, went three to four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and reached his best stride too late. PRECOCIOUS ZAK raced three wide on the first turn, was urged along the backstretch, raced between rivals on the far turn and came up empty.
