ITHINKIAMAWINNER broke a bit slow, moved up to take the lead, set the pace while off the rail, extended the lead in upper stretch and held under right hand urging. LOVING WARRIOR raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and closed well but was too late. EXPECTMONEY advanced on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and weakened while able to get the show. OLD CHUNK OF COAL chased the early pace then dropped back and tired. REGATTA TONE settled off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to respond. DOVE EXPRESS chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and faded. MALABAR SLEW was urged along on the inside, raced near the rail on the turn and faltered. EL LOBO ROJO chased the early pace then dropped back, raced three to four wide on the turn and stopped.
