Footnotes

YESSIRGENERALSIR set the clear pace while off the rail, drew off on the second turn, and maintained a safe advantage while kept to task. SONIC WEST was unhurried while off the rail, roused on the second turn, moved to the rail near the quarter-pole, brushed with KELA near the furlong marker, and finished willingly for second. SPANISH EMPIRE was hustled from the start, angled out to be three wide midway through the first turn, settled well off the pace, raced three wide on the second turn, and lacked the needed rally. KELA raced three wide on the first turn, came four wide onto the backstretch, tracked the pace set by the winner, dropped back while under a ride on the far turn, brushed with SONIC WEST near the furlong marker, and gave way. MAYSVILLE SLEW lagged well behind the field, saved ground into the stretch, angled out near the furlong marker, angled further out passing the sixteenth pole, and failed to reach serious contention. SAINT BUDDY raced four wide on the first turn, came five wide onto the backstretch, was forwardly placed on the outside, faltered on the far turn, and retreated then was not urged late.
