REDDING COLLIERY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival on the far turn, edged clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. AWESOME GEM raced between rivals on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was roused on the far turn and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. EUROEARS set the pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired while able to hold the show. FIFTEEN LOVE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced while three wide on the far turn and came up empty. GOLDEN YANK settled on the inside, shifted three wide near the three-eighths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. INDY EXPRESS lagged well behind the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. JONESBORO was urged along on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. MYTHICAL POWER settled off the pace, failed to respond when roused on the far turn and retreated.
