STAKES Dallas Turf Cup H. Listed - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO \$15,750 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start with \$150,000 guaranteed of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$16,500 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 115 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$25,000 twice on the turf since November 1, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; \$25,000 on the turf since November 1, 2009, 5 lbs.; \$20,000 since January 25, 2010, 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2009-2010 as determined by Equibase Company will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, May 20th with 39 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by mmanagement to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.). WISE RIVER bumped with a rival after the start, was well placed on the inside, moved up to contest the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied inside on the far turn, inched clear in upper stretch and held gamely under strong right hand urging. EL GATO MALO broke very awkwardly then was bumped on both sides, was rated just off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch and closed well but failed to reach the winner. GLOWING PRAISE (GB) bumped with a rival at the start, was a bit rank early then lingered towards the rear, came three wide into the stretch and finished well to just miss the place. UNBRIDLE'S DREAM broke outward at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. DEAL BREAKER (GB) settled on the inside of EL GATO MALO, saved ground on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. PRECIOUS COLONY contested the pace, dropped back a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased on the far turn, remained in striking range in the stretch, was taken up and steadied inside the sixteenth-pole and lost any chance at the minor awards. LITTLE WAGON lagged at the rear of the field while near the rail, moved out in mid-stretch and failed to rally. AND MUSIC CAME bumped with a rival at the start, was bumped early on the first turn then forced five wide, raced towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn and was no factor. FAVORITE JAZZ was hard held early, lagged towards the rear and failed to menace. JAKE WIL GALLOP bumped with a rival at the start, was rank on the inside, came out and bumped with AND MUSIC CAME early on the first turn, moved to four wide midway through that turn, was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the far turn and faltered. (Rail at 0 Feet)
