Footnotes

LAKE CHARLES prompted the pace while four wide, drew even for the lead entering the turn, raced four wide on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, and held PINE THYMEPRINCESS at bay in the final furlong. PINE THYMEPRINCESS was never far back, ranged up five wide on the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong, but couldn't get by the winner. SPLASHING JAZZ was allowed to settle into stride, rallied three wide entering the stretch, but lacked the needed response. HADETTE pressed the pace between rivals, drew even entering the turn, checked sharply between the five-sixteenth and quarter poles, and lost all chance. CURRY UP tracked the pace between rivals, drew even near the three-eighths pole, raced in tight quarters outside the quarter pole, and came up empty in the stretch drive. ROSE GLITTER bobbed after the start, rushed up to set the pace, dropped out midway through the final turn, steadied outside the quarter pole, and stopped. EL SINS took a few awkward steps entering the turn, and was pulled up, but walked off.
