Footnotes

PARKER RUN was off slow, dropped to the rail while well back in the field, saved ground on the turn, rallied entering the final furlong and closed with a rush to get up late. RANDOM GOLD dueled on the outside, drew off on the turn, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught. GLASS MACHINE showed speed between rivals, dropped back while in tight near the half-mile pole, chased inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. LUCADO broke outward and hit the gate, showed speed between rivals then chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and tired. CARLISLES JET dueled on the inside of rivals, chased while off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and gave way. GREGGO was void of speed, raced four wide into the turn then dropped in, came up the rail in upper stretch and never reached contention. MR. EXCELLENT was ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WILD SERIES was hard ridden on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. LAST FOAL dropped back while racing erratically, went three wide on the turn and showed little. (Rail at 10 Feet)
