### Footnotes

YES IT'S OK set the pace, went three then two wide on the turn, extended the advantage under a few taps of a right-handed whip in upper stretch and drew off while shown the whip to prove much the best. BRICK MAKER broke a bit slow, was urged along while off the pace, went four wide on the turn and narrowly earned the place. RUNSTEVIERUN was well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, chased the leader, came out at the top of the stretch and proved no match for the winner then just missed the place. JOHNNY'S SLICE raced just off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went three then two wide on the turn and tired. STRATEGIC PLAYER broke a bit slow, moved up on the outside, vied four then three wide on the turn and weakened. RED CADILLAC broke about three lengths slow, raced towards the rear, went five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. ASAVACHE chased the pace, checked leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. LONESOME WHO acted-up at the break, broke about fourteen lengths behind the field and trailed.
