KATOUR disputed the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, drifted seven to eight wide into upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. CARE FOR ME jumped shadows while setting the pace, vied inside on the turn, battled into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. HAZEL RUN raced just behind the inside pacesetter, chased off the rail on the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was outkicked while clear for the show. BRIGHT PERFECTION was urged along in fourth position, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. LUCY J was urged along while off the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to rally. SNOOKIE CAT moved in while ridden along off the pace, raced off heels passing the three-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. CEE CEE GRAND was urged along in the middle of the field, went three wide on the turn and failed to respond. NATIVE HUNTER bumped hard with a rival at the start then was in tight, was urged along towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and was no factor. RAINBOW SEEKER was hard ridden on the outside, went four wide on the turn and also failed to respond. MO MOVE was reluctant to load, bumped hard with a rival at the start then was taken up, raced at the rear of the field and never reached contention. (Rail at 10 Feet)
