Footnotes

IT'S AN ADVENTURE showed good natural speed, controlled the tempo while off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, drew clear into the final furlong and proved much the best while ridden out. SIMPLY SCANDALOUS broke in at the start, showed good early speed, chased the winner while inside on the turn, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and safely secured the place then was hand ridden late. RANGER HILL veered in at the start, was ridden along on the inside, came off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response while up for the show near the wire. KIEARA WISH chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired then was caught for the show. GRAMMAS BOY was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn and failed to respond. BIG RED SURPRISE was off a couple of lengths slow, rushed up on the backstretch, chased four wide on the turn and weakened then drifted out in the final furlong. BEST DAY (MEX) hesitated at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and had nothing left. PASS EM KRISTIN was reluctant to load, raced well back in the field, went three then two wide on the turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole and also failed to respond. RED BIRD'S ANDDAN raced at the rear of the field, went five then four wide on the turn and was no factor.
