MALABAR SLEW was ridden along on the inside, shifted out leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. ST. RAPHAEL (IRE) was urged along on the inside, bumped with BUBBALEWSKI leaving the backstretch then steadied, saved ground on the turn, moved out behind rivals in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the place. SEMICONDUCTOR was ridden along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, made a bid between rivals near the furlong marker but was outfinished while able to get the show. CENTAUR'S PROSPECT contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. BUBBALEWSKI was urged along while off the pace, bumped with ST. RAPHAEL leaving the backstretch then steadied slightly, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. FLATLAND FEVER contested the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, waited while blocked from the three-sixteenths pole to near the sixteenth-pole and lost his best chance. TRULY TRULY TRULY contested the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn, vied into the final furlong and tired. BLUE MEMO broke a bit slow then dropped back, fell well behind and trailed.
