SPARK PLUG contested the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn, inched clear near the quarter-pole, drew away in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong urging. FILET GUMBO disputed the pace, vied inside on the turn and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. PACHECO was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly to get the show. COOK'S NOOK chased the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn and tired. SIR JAIME showed good speed then chased on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn and weakened. BETCHO settled off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the turn and failed to rally. CALCULATED MOVE was urged along while off the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to threaten. RARE FLYER was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn and was no factor. BOTTOM TO TOP was taken up slightly leaving the chute, raced towards the inside while ridden along and faltered.
