BEACHCOMBING bumped with a rival at the start, dropped in before the first turn, raced just off the pace, waited while inside on the far turn, hesitated while in tight quarters against the rail in upper stretch, squeezed through to grab the lead near the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under a hand ride. RICH JEWEL contested the pace on the inside, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the place. QUE DESEO settled towards the rear while saving ground, moved closer on the far turn, shifted off the rail in upper stretch and finished willingly to garner the show. SOMMER'S CHOICE went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and also finished willingly. MR. MIDNIGHT raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. BENDANIE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, raced off heels from the quarter-pole into the stretch and lacked the needed response. MR. WHY WHY disputed the pace while off the rail, vied into the final furlong and weakened. PRIVATE CAT went four to five wide on the first turn, raced up close to the pace, chased four to five wide on the far turn and tired. OVERNIGHT FLIGHT lunged at the start, went three to four wide on the first turn, contested the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and faded then was eased in the final furlong but walked off. INDISPUTABLE raced five to six wide on the first turn, was through after a half-mile and stopped then was eased in the stretch but walked off. HY LIME TIME settled towards the rear, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, broke down on the far turn and was vanned off. (Rail at 10 Feet)
