GOT NO EXCUSE was ridden along while off the pace, raced two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. WILLOWY DANSEUR was bumped on both sides at the start, disputed the pace while between rivals, inched clear into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was denied. BROTHER DARRELL was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside, lacked room while in tight behind the winner near the eighth-pole, altered course to the outside and finished willingly for the show. FAN CLUB was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and finished with good energy. MIDLAND MAN bumped with a rival at the start, threw his head while very rank early, dropped back while racing erratically, went four wide into the turn, swerved six wide near the three-eighths pole, continued six wide into the stretch and reached his best stride too late. SUPER STRUGGLER contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. AINTTHATAKICKINTHE chased the pace on the inside, raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick. KRISTYS CACTUS BOY broke out at the start, raced well back in the field, went five wide into the turn, was carried seven wide near the three-eighths pole, dropped in outside the quarter-pole, angled out at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. SUNDAY PREMIERE chased the early pace, dropped back while off the rail on

the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. BUBBLE B. BUDDHA chased the pace then dropped back, raced inside on the turn and failed to rally. BET ON SUNDAY bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. MAGESTIC WILDCAT raced towards the rear, went five wide on the turn and was no factor.
