ALPHA LUCKY brushed with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn,was given his cue passing the quarter-pole, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole and drew away under urging then was hand ridden late. SLEEVE was ridden along at the back of the field, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, swung seven wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. BARCLAY DRIVE was urged along on the inside of EXPLOSIVE OKIE, raced four then five wide on the turn, came in nearing the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. EXPLOSIVE OKIE broke out at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced five then six wide on the turn and tired. DOC POSSE dueled on the outside, vied four then three wide on the turn, led into the stretch but gave way. STAN MICHAEL L was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, steadied off heels near the furlong marker and failed to rally. DEPAUL brushed with a rival at the start, dueled between horses, vied three then two wide on the turn and capitulated. ALFRED KENT pressed the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn, waited while blocked from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths pole, moved out near the furlong marker and had nothing left. BENITO dueled for the lead, vied into the stretch and also tired. GUILTYASCAANBE was urged along while off the pace, came between rivals midway through the turn, was blocked passing the quarter-pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch, steadied between rivals near the furlong marker and dropped out.
