Footnotes

ACTIVE TREASURE set the clear pace while on the inside, responded well when set down in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth and was all out to last. GOLD WONDER raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled in the middle of the field, was roused while three then four wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to just miss. TANALIAN settled in the back half of the field while off the rail, was roused on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to just miss. VALID MESSAGE lingered near the back while on the inside, swung five wide into the stretch and finished fast but was too late. DOHNSTER raced two then three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight, chased on the far turn and finished willingly but missed. CHANDAS raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole, came six wide into the stretch and improved position. WINCHESTER BAY settled in the second flight while off the

rail, was urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed response. WALKWAY settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. UBET' YAH raced inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. ROAD WORK settled at the back of the field, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to threaten. DOMENICK'S DUNE settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn and came up empty. ZONE AGAIN raced three then four wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and gave way. (Rail at 10 Feet)
