**Footnotes**

STONE COLD KITTY chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, drifted in shortly thereafter and prevailed under strong urging. ALL THERE was hard ridden in the middle of the field, came three wide into the stretch, chased the winner determinedly in the final furlong but was second best. EXPECT SMOKE was ridden along on the inside, dropped back while saving ground on the turn, moved to three wide near the quarter-pole, brushed with JOLIE STREETS in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. JOLIE STREETS broke outward then showed no speed, angled in at the back of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out then brushed with EXPECT SMOKE in upper stretch and improved position. DEVIL'S DICTATE broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. I'M THE CAT bumped with a rival at the start, chased the leader through the turn and tired. BUBBAMYSTER sped clear and set the pace, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. SEYMOUR NAEVUS raced well back in the field, went three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor. BELTON was fractious in the gate, chased the pace near the inside, saved ground on the turn and also gave way. TEXAS TALL TALE was fractious in the gate, raced off the pace while hard ridden and failed to respond.
