Footnotes

PACIFIC TSUNAMI bumped with a rival at the start, dueled on the outside, edged clear in upper stretch and proved best under right hand urging. TOGA TOO broke inward and bumped with a rival, was ridden along while off the pace and finished willingly for the place. HIGH LAKE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and also finished willingly but missed the place. EYE WONDER bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and weakened. C D CASH bumped with a rival at the start, dueled on the inside and gave way. COUNTDOWN'S SEVEN lacked early speed and showed little. DALLAS COUNTY was ridden along towards the rear, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. AINTTHATAKICKINTHE was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced four to five wide on the turn and came up empty.
