VARIANCE raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace, was challenged on the far turn, shook off GOLD WONDER inside the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. GOLD WONDER saved ground on the first turn, tracked the pace, made a bid outside the leader on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. KING OF SPEED settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. HARBOUR CITY steadied and was forced ten wide late on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and finished willingly in a good effort. POP HIT broke inward at the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, saved ground on the far turn and failed to rally. THUNDERPANTS stumbled at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. SHAKE A LAKE was taken up at the start, checked sharply late on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. STEPHENGOTHISSTAR broke a bit slow, jumped a shadow late on the first turn and nearly unseated the rider, had the rider lose his right iron and was pulled up but walked off. OBJECTIVE settled on the inside, dropped out nearing the first turn and was pulled up then vanned off. (Rail at 10 Feet)
