**Footnotes**

AUSTIN LIGHTS bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, made a bid between rivals with three furlongs to run, edged clear in upper stretch and drew away under strong hand urging. FILET GUMBO raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled on the inside of HAVEUSEENTHELIGHT, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. FLIGHTY FRIEND raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn, came between rivals late and got up for the show. KACEYNTHEMOONLITE broke inward and bumped with a rival, set the pace while off the rail, vied inside on the far turn and tired. TAKSENT was caught four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader leaving the backstretch, vied three wide on the far turn and came up empty. NO RISK NO GAIN lagged at the rear of the field, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. CROOK'S ADVENTURE dropped back while in a bit tight nearing the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, lingered near the back of the field, hesitated while behind a rival near the quarter-pole and never reached contention. PORTATE BIEN raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, came up empty while three wide on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole and faded. HAVEUSEENTHELIGHT raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was in a bit tight near the half-mile pole, went four then three wide on the far turn and faltered.
