Footnotes

MAGGIES SNOWMAN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, gained the lead inside the furlong marker and inched clear under strong urging. RISEN IN DEED bumped lightly with a rival at the start, sped clear and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while just able to hold the place. DOUGH DOUGH DOUGH chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. SEEKING TO RUN was reluctant to load, raced in the middle of the field while urged along, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. BUCKABOO broke in the air but relatively with the field, raced towards the rear, went three then two wide on the turn and was no factor. RACKET MAN was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. QUIET DOMINATION was ridden along at the rear, raced four wide on the turn and trailed.
