Footnotes

CHIFFOROBEBE disputed the pace, moved clear leaving the backstretch, controlled the action on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and proved best under steady urging. CRIMSON LAKE disputed the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide on the turn and was second best. THE RED GUY raced just off the pace while off the inside, was driven four wide at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. CRAFTY TALENT chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and tired. EL PETIZO settled off the pace, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. SMARTYLIKESTOPARTY chased the pace on the outside, came under the whip near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three wide on the turn and capitulated. ANDANOITED broke two lengths slow, dropped well behind, raced inside on the turn and trailed.
