AWASARUMOR broke slow, racing from the rear, came around the final turn four wide and made a late outside rally, getting up in time. ZARB'S STAR hopped out at the break, quickly went to the front, opened up on the field, lead until late, caught at the wire. KACEY QUICK raced behind ZARB'S STAR in the early part, close throughout. RAYOFSUNSHINE raced in the middle of the field in the beginning, made a mild bid. ICEE HAWK raced within contention, moved up, then lacked a late rally. EAGER EATER raced in the middle of the pack and put forth an even effort. DIAMONDS AND JADE void of early speed, improved position, but was no factor. BRIEF VALENTINE raced within contention, saved ground and finished early. BOLD AND PEACEFUL lacked early speed, moved up, then retreated. STIRLING BRIDGE raced near the back and was never close.
