Footnotes

PLAN NINE jostled with a rival after the start, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. SENORA TORMENTA was in tight entering the first turn, settled inside on the backstretch, was roused on the far turn and secured the place while no match for the winner. OSWEGO raced three wide into the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was rated just behind the leader, vied outside on the far turn and weakened. RICE 'N SPICE bumped into the hindquarters of SPEED FEST entering the first turn then steadied, moved to three wide late on that turn, was reserved off the pace, waited while blocked from the three-sixteenths pole into the final furlong and failed to rally in a brutal trip. SPEED FEST jostled with a rival after the start, was bumped in the hindquarters entering the first turn then lost position, dropped to the rear entering the backstretch, lingered at the back while under a hold, came under a ride on the far turn, raced three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. KATYS GOLD TOUCH veered out at the start and hit the gate, had the rider lose his right iron briefly, regained the iron nearing the first turn, moved up while four then three wide on that turn, settled outside on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and had nothing left.
