MY STAR RUNNER chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch and drew off then was hand ridden late. UNO DUCKSY was ridden along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and got up for the place. TOMAHAWK CREEK set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened while able to hold the show. KAJIWARA pressed the pace on the inside, moved out leaving the backstretch, chased two to three wide on the turn and tired. TORTUGA STRAITS chased the early pace then dropped back, raced two then three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. MALABAR SLEW was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. EURO SILVER JET raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn and was no factor. MOMMA'S BADNEWS bobbled at the start, dropped well behind and trailed.
