**Footnotes**

YOUCANNOTBESERIOUS dueled on the inside of OPTIONAL, disposed of that rival inside the furlong marker and drew off under steady urging. OPTIONAL dueled on the outside, vied into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. F C HALO ELITE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. KIMBELL'S BLING was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally. VANITY'S SHOWCASE chased the pace, raced three wide early on the turn then dropped in, saved ground into the stretch and tired. THRIVING was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, drifted out late and failed to threaten. BROADWAY ALI was ridden along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. MESCALERESS angled in at the rear of the field, came three wide into the stretch and never reached contention. MISS BUSY lunged slightly at the start but broke with the field, raced towards the rear, went four to five wide on the turn and also failed to respond. WHY'S THAT was ridden along in the back half of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and retreated.
