SHARON RAE set the clear pace, was challenged on the far turn, edged clear again when set down at the top of the stretch and held gamely under strong right hand urging. CIELI saved ground while rated, was blocked from the three-eighths pole to inside the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide into the stretch and closed well but was too late. MAGIC STREAK reared at the start, was reserved at the back of the field while off the rail, came between rivals at the top of the stretch, angled in near the furlong marker and finished willingly. GOLD CASE MOTEL raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths marker, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths marker, failed to match strides with the winner in upper stretch then weakened. TOCHA was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, made a bid while three wide near the five-sixteenths marker, dropped back a bit at the top of the stretch, steadied outside the furlong marker and gave way. MARQUISE QUEST tracked the pace while off the rail, chased inside on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 20 Feet)
