**Footnotes**

WAGER N WIN settled just off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled on the outside with DRINK AND A WINK while under left hand urging, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider and switched to a right-handed whip then drew clear under good handling. DRINK AND A WINK raced three then two wide on the first turn, moved up inside MY MINNIE LEE to contest the pace entering the backstretch, inched clear while off the rail on the far turn, was challenged at the top of the stretch, dueled with the winner into the final sixteenth then proved no match while just able to get the place. WATERTOWN ROAD raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, moved closer while inside on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and just missed the place. KELATEQUILA broke in and bumped with a rival, raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and tired. CLIFF'SNAUGHTYGIRL was caught four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. STRONG LADY bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved near the back of the field, went two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SWEETEST DAWN was carried in at the start, lingered near the back and never reached contention. SILVER RED BIRD was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside while towards the front, dropped back while four wide on the far turn and faded. SEA SLEW raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. MY MINNIE LEE showed early speed, lugged out a bit late on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and stopped. INDIGO JADE broke a bit awkwardly and was last away, moved up before the first turn, raced just off the

pace while on the inside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped out midway through the far turn and stopped. BONNIES MILL raced four wide on the first turn and was outrun.
