Footnotes

PORT OF SEATTLE chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and drew clear under moderate hand urging. SUPER STRUGGLER was reluctant to load, contested the pace, vied inside on the turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. COOK'S NOOK was ridden along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and was best of the rest. WHIRLING CREST pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. BIG TONY disputed the pace between rivals, dropped out midway through the turn and weakened. RIZZI MONEY was void of speed, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. GOLDANDSILVER was ridden along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. SPEED MONSTER chased the early pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole and faded.
