WILBY'S RAY was sent hard from the start, dueled on the inside of DRUNK DIAL, lost touch with that rival near the quarter-pole and proved no match while well clear for the place. WIMBLEDON'S FIRE was ridden along at the back of the trio, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
