Footnotes

PHILLY R bobbled slightly just after the start, was coaxed along while just off the pace, advanced three wide early on the turn, gained the lead nearing the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail while moving clear and drew off under a strong drive. PRINCE ALEX showed speed then was taken in hand, raced just off the pace while under some restraint along the rail, moved out on the turn, made his way to three wide by the quarter-pole and was second best. SLAMMING G disputed the pace on the outside, vied off the rail early on the turn, came under the whip at the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide late on the bend, chased into upper stretch and tired while best of the rest. ECONOMIC RECOVERY settled off the pace, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide late on the bend and came up empty. PROUDTOBEAPLAYER was hustled from the start, dropped back midway down the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and failed to respond. HENRY THE ACE was urged along on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and was outrun. GOODER was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside of a rival, vied inside on the turn, dropped out near the five-sixteenths pole and stopped. AGGIES CAT M H F settled on the inside of a rival while well back, came under urging near the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little.
