HI BALL was in a bit tight early, settled at the rear, advanced quickly while three wide early on the turn, waited off heels passing the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out a path after turning into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under strong handling. MAGNA BREEZE disputed the pace on the inside of a rival while off the rail, dropped back between rivals at the quarter-pole, chased under the whip into the final furlong, re-bid near the sixteenth pole but was outfinished while able to get the place. FINANCIAL REPAIR chased the pace on the inside, made a rail bid near the five-sixteenths pole, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to get the show. CAYOTE ROJO was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and tired. JET KID tracked the pace on the outside, went four wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased into the final furlong and capitulated. TUCO'S REVENGE was urged along towards the back, raced inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. MERTZIES PRIDE was urged along on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn, moved in near the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally.
