Footnotes

TOUCH OF CREME was reserved off the pace, moved closer on the far turn, rallied four wide at the top of the stretch and closed strongly to get up late. DURRYMANE was well placed on the inside, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, drifted six wide while making a bid entering the stretch, inched clear while drifting in outside the furlong marker and was caught. PERFECT RUBY was in tight early, settled off the pace, steadied while blocked leaving the far turn, rallied in upper stretch and finished willingly. EDDIES GIRL contested the pace on the inside, bumped with OSWEGO midway down the backstretch, vied inside through the far turn and weakened. SOFT N' LOUD raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, came under a ride on the far turn, was carried out late and failed to respond. OSWEGO contested the pace on the outside, bumped with EDDIES GIRL midway down the backstretch, vied into the stretch, drifted out late and gave way. CRYPTO NOTE raced four to five wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn and tired. LADY LOLA lagged well behind the field and was always outrun. (Rail at 20 Feet)
