Footnotes

DOUBLE O UNO was a bit rank early then reserved well off the pace, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. FREE SAILING tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid on the far turn, battled gamely in the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. FIRST ACT raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up near the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the far turn then moved off the rail, battled determinedly in the stretch and missed but earned the show. RANGE MAN raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly but missed the minor awards. RUSH FOR GOLD was last away, saved ground on the first turn, moved out and advanced on the backstretch, raced three to four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. CAPTURE THE FLAG raced three wide on the first turn, moved up near the half-mile pole, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, vied into the final furlong and weakened. DOITFORJOHNNY bumped with a rival at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. WEISS GUY was rated off the pace, saved ground on both turns and came up empty. SHADOW'S BABY bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and gave way. LONE STAR GENERAL saved ground on the first turn, lagged near the back, raced off the rail on the far turn and was no factor. DR. PAYSEUR raced three wide early on the first turn then moved in, settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 20 Feet)
