Footnotes

OLD CHUNK OF COAL bobbled at the start but showed good speed, chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, moved to three wide near the quarter-pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch and inched clear under strong urging. GOLDEN CHAPEL bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out a bit in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. STRAIGHT PARADE was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. MALABAR SLEW set the pace, came off the rail on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened. VALSBOAT broke a bit awkwardly, was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. BRICK FIGHT dropped back while ridden along, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. TYLER ROSEMAN showed good speed then chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. COLOSSAL FIRE broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field while near the rail and was no factor. DISTINCTLY ZARB dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turn and was outrun. WINNER'S STORY bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along in the back half of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond.
