LITTLE TALK sped clear after the start, dictated terms through the turn while a bit off the rail, responded well in the stretch and held gamely under strong urging. BEAT THE CHEAT chased the pace on the outside, raced two to three wide on the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but missed. OUTFITTER chased the pace near the inside, saved ground on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch, loomed boldly entering the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the show. PRACTICE TEE was ridden along between rivals, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. WESTERN FORUM lacked early speed, raced near the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. EVENING REWARD was urged along between rivals, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. SAINT'S RELIC bobbled ever so slightly at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and also came up empty. EXPLOSIVE OKIE was ridden along between rivals, steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. SAN TURNERO was taken up a bit at the start then dropped back, fell far behind the field and trailed.
