Footnotes

CROOK'S STYLE was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, responded well when put to the whip passing the three-sixteenths pole, disposed of RESTLESS STAR entering the final furlong and drew clear under strong urging. RESTLESS STAR broke about two lengths slow, moved up to race just off the pace while off the rail, chased on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and weakened while well clear for the place. YOU BETTER was a bit rank in the very early going, raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, steadied off heels near the three-eighths pole, raced two to three wide on the far turn, moved into third in upper stretch and earned the show while no match for the top two. STREETWISE raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, dropped back while three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. SWEET TEXAS STAR was caught five wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. CHIQUITA MARIA raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and faded. YVONS GOLD settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and retreated.
