**Footnotes**

DELWOOD went three wide on the first turn, raced towards the front of the field, chased three wide on the far turn, drifted four wide into the stretch, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, drifted out while battling with GARCIA'S LETTER in the final furlong and prevailed under left hand urging. GARCIA'S LETTER raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, chased inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied nearing the eighth-pole, drifted out while battling with the winner in the final furlong and missed. NORTH GOAL raced six then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn, moved out while chasing the top two in the final furlong and finished willingly for the show. SKIPPY WAS A HIPPIY was asked from the start, set the clear pace, came under urging on the far turn, led into the final furlong then weakened. DECLARED TONE raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. LOUISIANA BANDIT settled near the middle of the field, raced near the inside on the turns and lacked the needed response. SHANNON'S PHANTOM lagged at the rear of the field, was roused on the far turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, angled out once straightened for the drive and failed to threaten. GO FOR DOUGH saved ground on the first turn, raced towards the front of the field, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired. WAR WHOOP raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace and failed to respond. HAMMER'S VIEW raced three wide on the first turn, followed the clear leader and stopped after a half-mile.
