Footnotes

DREAM TRIPPER set the clear pace, was challenged by CAT ANTE with three furlongs to run, exchanged bumps with that rival at the top of the stretch, dueled into the final yards, and prevailed under steady handling. CAT ANTE tracked the pace, engaged DREAM TRIPPER passing the three-eighths pole, exchanged bumps with that rival entering the stretch, dueled into the final sixteenth, and missed in a good effort. CODE OF THE HILLS pulled hard under a strangle hold on the first turn, settled down on the backstretch, and failed to rally in an even effort. EYE WITNESS broke inward and bumped a rival, raced four wide on both turns, and was no factor. CAREFREE JIM raced up close early, was in tight near the six furlong marker, dropped back on the backstretch, and failed to threaten. JUDGE RAY was bumped at the start then squeezed back, raced under a tight hold into the backstretch, and showed little. ROYAL WULFF leaned in at the start and hit the gate, raced well back in the field, and was outrun.
