Footnotes

THEATRICAL DANCER was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn, lacked room near the quarter-pole, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, and closed strongly to get up late. SHANNON LEE was slow into stride, chased the pace on the inside, dueled with D.J. DEVIL CAT on the turn, kicked clear into the final furlong, and was caught in the final strides. JARED'S TWILIGHT settled well back in the field, raced four wide on the turn, and finished willingly. BUSY LINE raced towards the rear of the field, lacked room in upper stretch, and failed to threaten. WALESA MISS C was forwardly placed from the start, vied just off the rail on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch, lacked room near the sixteenth marker, and gave way. D. J. DEVIL CAT was away alertly from the outside post, set the pace under pressure, dueled on the outside of SHANNON LEE on the turn, vied into upper stretch, and faded. DIRTY SECRET was off a step slow, advanced near the half-mile marker, vied between rivals early on the turn, came up empty near the quarter-pole, and faltered. MAGIC SPARKLES raced up close on the outside, dropped back while four wide early on the turn, dropped to three wide midway through the turn, drifted five wide near the quarter-pole, and stopped.
