Footnotes

HOW'S THAT broke outward and bumped lightly with a rival, was well rated while a bit off the rail, responded well in the stretch and held under strong urging. WALKWAY was rated on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and finished willingly to just get the place. DAUGHTRY was taken back under a very tight hold then moved out, raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly but missed the place. STATICE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn and also finished willingly but missed the minor awards. SILVER HAZE bumped with rivals at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. JO'S THUNDER raced off the rail on the first turn then settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. GROOM'S CAT lagged at the rear of the field, shifted three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. CLUB TEJANO bumped with a rival at the start, raced three to four wide on the turns and failed to threaten. FRENCH HIT settled on the inside, raced near the rail on the far turn and failed to menace. CAPTAIN KITE broke outward at the start, settled towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turns and failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
